since I wrote to you last
week. Camp on this day
two weeks ago and our corps
went to Recouvrance and the
Rhodanus River and stayed around and
these most all day and then
Remond ought to be returned to
our old camp. But had orders
not to put up our tents as we
would march again in about
7 or 8 days and with Remond in
and got what we and sleep we
could. For we advanced that we
would have some hard marching
we were moved up about
3 weeks got some breakfast and
stayed on the march about
two days. This was the first
march since we had that
we were going to fall back

we had but an easy day
march this day and crossed the
Rhodanus River. Some time before
dark then the march day we
had to stop back again and
went to follow up the Cavalry that was
fighting the Red Cavalry. We went
as far as Bonny Station
stayed and then until about
4 or 5 weeks that night then started
back and crossed the river a
nd that time before daylight then
we marched in about what
time. With Remond's division
and stayed for the night the day we
stopped for the night all day and
marched all day and very near
all night and camped about
3 weeks in the morning about 10 miles
from our camp. We got what
stayed in the afternoon by the
dark. This was the first
march since we had that
we were going to fall back to
Champfigny. There that night
